Chambers where they do their business, and Young Gentlemen intend to follow the Employment of an Advocate or Writer, the signet are generally Convened and Maintained in the Livery of Stile & Chancery Hall, the Master and other of the Ancient Bar and from thence under the pain of Deprivation but 13 Pds 10 s. And to keep them in Mind thereof they are annually set forth in black gowns before the Lord's in presence, and Enjoyned by the President to keep the Dd. Style & Coronial custom having in among the servants of writers to the first of the following Master in Corporation to Bills & finally drawn by writers, practice was discharged under the pain of fols & good and proper Act of Par. 31 Feby 1645.

Some of the writers to the signet are appointed by the Secretary of State at pleasure, to be of his Court & called his informers of the signet, of whom five with one of the Signet keepers are a quorum their business is to Manage affairs of the Society, if any doubt relating to form and Style and to Direct writers in their duty. It is not to infect many others as being the signet. More precept decrees contracts or obligations, one, or in any letter of Remitting More decrees or bonds than shall be precept of Superior courts contain More bonds or Decrees than One, and to seall every Remitting have a sealed paper and that each remitted Bill of Exchange or precept have a separate Remitting and Description, albeit the said ones excepting Bonds and Decrees, bills and precepts to no exceeding 40 pounds of principal in each of them, and bonds or Bills and precepts granted by the same debtor to the same creditor, not being an half yearly; whereof two or three or more may be put in the same Remitting and Compounded for all the signet but of the writers to the signet 19 March 1722. Nor to fill for any writing peculiar to the writers to the signet, that are not written by themselves or their habitual servants and apprentices serving in their own Chambers; except such as shall be furnished for brethren writers to the signet conform to their written warrant to the brother signing for another to whom the brother signing for another must subscribe and subscribe a note of the latter summons precept and others to be signed by him, and the warrant is to be shown to the under deacons of the signet, when such letters and others are given unto to be signed. Both Bills of Invocation and Dismission signatures and preceps must be drawn by the Abbot brother or by the signet and

and written by the servant of the abbot brother which warrant given by abbot brother to sign for them to use for three Monthes, and may after expiring thereof be renewed for other three Monthes, and if the abbot brother longer than three Monthes, the keeper and Commissioners may by application made to them, prorogate their power of granting warrants for three Monthes Longer. At the start winter to the signet to subscribe any writs upon him to writers to the signet for less than the prices established by Law, except at the instance of those whom he is allowed to serve gratified, etc. The secretaries of State and their Deputies, lords of sessions, Justices, Clerks of session, Clerks of the Bills and their Deputyes, clerks and Clerks of Treasury, keepers and writers to the seals, writers to the signet, Clerks and keepers of the General Register of Writings and Seals, Masters before the lords of Sessions privy Council are Eschequers and the writers own apprentices and servants they not being assigned, and shall in the present Roll, or such as are known to be writer to be paid. A Writer transcribing or counterfeiting any of these Injunctions is to be suspended for three Monthes and to pay to the treasurer of the Society 40 pound for the first fault, and to be suspended for six Monthes for the second fault, and to pay 30 pound of fine before the suspension be removed. The each winter to the signet will upon the first Monday of July and December yearly oral leave within 3 days of the said respective first Mondays make oath that he shall not contrive or boast to the signet before said time points before the keeper and Commissioners of the Society for the hinder day his of the year otherwise than effect are to be placed at the signet till they purge themselves by such an Oath. If any Member be suspended upon such a verse before a bare commission, he shall not only pay his fine before he is restored to the exercise of his office, but also be left last in the Roll of the writers for the third Act of the writers to the signet 19 feb 1722.

In General Meetings of the Society the Commissioners are necessary members in order to make Rules for the better Discharging the duty of writers to the signet to judge and try their abuses and misdeemours and punish delinquents according to the degree of their offence to the signet.
