 as to Renounce God and Eternal Happiness and
 lastingly bind their souls and bodies for a short
 Interest. For if Men of Liberal Education and Acquire-
 ment, that know their Duty and their Danger, are
 by their appetites with their Eyes upon the
 fatal Rocks, and made all the East - they can
 their God and their Happiness; if such can barter their
 for trifles, and sell Everlasting for a Moment; upon
 upon the Brink of a precipice, and Contemn all the
 of the future Dreadfull day, why should it be
 that a British vile person, filled with Ignorance
 Brink with all the Windings of God and Unconcern
 about a future Being should be persuaded to accept
 of present Delightfull Gratifications, without
 weighing the Desperate Condition?

A Fair Compact with Satan is 1. when persons
 do by Superstitious forms of prayer earnestly
