

Cap. d. Jul. doth ill. Thus the laws of other Nations, by
 Commodities, if possible, deliver to die more than once. The
 kind of death hath not always ordinary where born in the
 Generally such atrocious Criminals are condemned to be bur-
 ned, because the Inhabitants of Doom and Gomorah were of
 this Crime Destroyed by fire and Brimstone rained from
 Heaven Gen. 19.24. Which punishment it inflicted both
 the Agent and patient, whether man or woman or beast: it
 beafts are in such a case cut off, Rather for a bolstering the
 Memory of so horrid a wickedness, than as of orders from
 the law. But where a Boy or Girl Sodomitically, a beafts
 within the age of Distinction, the agent or a beafts, is
 put to death Coke 3 Inst. 29. By the law of England Treason
 or Buggery is felony without the Benefit of Clergy 2 Inst.
 & Cap. 6. Stat. 5 Eliz. cap. 17. Some Ancient Law Books
 that Crime treason is treason against the King of Heaven
 or a Rebellion against the order of Nature which is
 Establish'd.

We have no Express Statute in Scotland for punish-
 ing Sodomy, but it hath always been puni-
 death of one kind or others. And it is commonly accepted
 of a General Pardone. A Man for working with his Body
 as a stoned horse up to do, was ordained to be hang'd
 the Mars to be put to death 28 December 1691 of whom
 W. Phant. Another for Copulations with a Mars was
 ordain'd to the like punishment very early in the Morning
 and the Mars to be drowned in a Moss or Loch 15 February
 1649 James Wilson. Another man was for committing
 tiality with a Boy, adjudg'd to be hang'd beafts the
 and five in the Morning 1 July 1717 Robert Howie. A man
 was ordain'd to be drowned beafts four and five in
 the Morning for bestiality with mares Fords and a horse
 31 March 1695 James Mitchell. A Man was adjudg'd
 be strangled at a stake and burnt for Carnal Copula-
 tion with a Cow 31 May 1650 James Fiddes. Another
 the like judgement for bestiality committed by him
 with a Mare 9 April 1672 Major Wirt. And Another for
 the like Crime committed with four Mares and two

17 April 1662 Andrew Love. And one that was condemned
 to be strangled at a stake and burnt beafts four and five
 a beafts in the Morning for Carnal Copulation with a
 Bitch, and the beafts to be put to death 10 July 1679 John
 White. An Hermaphrodite qualified with the use of both
 Sexes who pass'd for and bore the Name of a Woman, ha-
 ving as a Male had Carnal Copulation with a beafts
 mare, was ordain'd to be strangled at a stake and the
 Mars to be killed, and both to be burnt, and
 the Value of the Mars to be given to the owner thereof
 2 February 1653 Margat Rany.

Some lawyers hold an Attempt to commit Buggery
 to be as highly punishable as the Crime itself if the
 offender did all that lay in his power to execute his
 lust full Design, and was only botched by some Inter-
 vening Accident. See Gait's space public lib. 1 cap. 14 n. 26.
