Tho' the Hypothec upon the cattle and other Stocking of the Ground is but for one year at a rate of £10 per Acre, a competent sum must be allowed to the master after the Term of payment of the yearly Rent for making his Hypothec effectual which he cannot do during the time before the Rent is due and of the Hypothec was found to last only till the next day after the term masters tolls & to provide their Rentals for their Rents the day before which would be intolerable Rigour; ~~therefore~~ it being necessary where it is agreed a well paid Rent of one Term to be discharged before another fall due.
